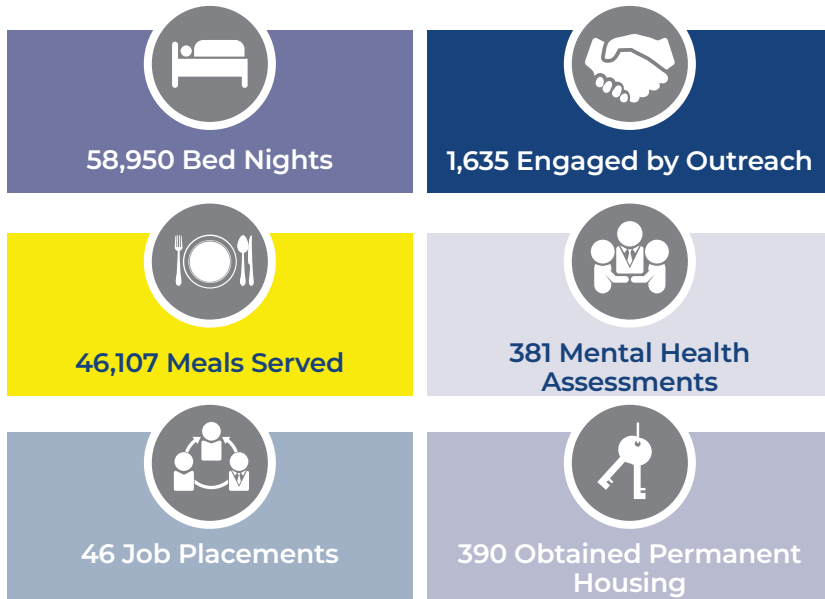

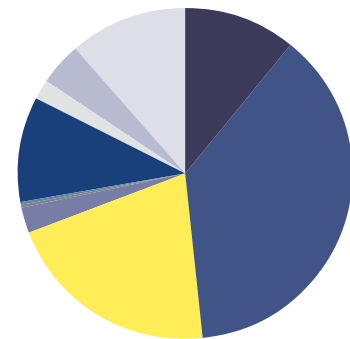

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

HOUSING

Transitional, emergency and permanent, move-in assistance, utility assistance, housing search, furniture and household goods

COUNSELING

Individual and group mental health, PTSD, substance abuse treatment, inner conflict

CASE MANAGEMENT

Individualized case plans, goals, advocacy, benefits assistance

TRANSPORTATION

Rides to appointments and community resources

SUPPORTIVE SERVICES

Financial assistance, Healthcare benefits access assistance, rent payments, eviction prevention services, general household items assistance, utility payments, car repairs, rapid re-housing

CAREER SERVICES

Career center, job interview skills, job search assistance, clothing, supportive employment needs

LIFE SKILLS GROUPS

Culinary skills training, sobriety support, hiking, writing, motivation, meditation, art therapy

OUTREACH

Clothing, emergency shelter, food
