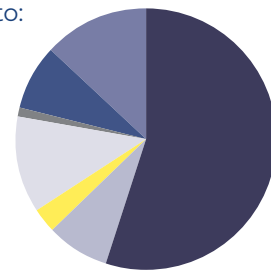

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

HOUSING

Transitional, emergency and permanent supportive, move-in and utility assistance, housing search

COUNSELING

Individual, behavioral health and substance use treatment, PTSD, cognitive behavioral therapy, anger management

CASE MANAGEMENT

Individualized case plans, goals, advocacy, legal services

OUTREACH

Veteran Service Center: Provides clothing, emergency shelter, food, showers, meals, computer lab, employment assistance

CAREER SERVICES

Career center, job interview skills, job search assistance, clothing, supportive employment needs

LIFE SKILLS GROUPS

Culinary skills training, sobriety support, hiking, writing, motivation, meditation, art therapy
