



FORT WHIPPLE

THE NEED

Prescott, Arizona is home to many men and women who bravely served our country. Veterans, many of whom are senior or disabled, make up 20% of the homeless population in the Prescott area. As our local rental market is at 98% capacity and the few available rentals cost a minimum of 150% above Fair Market Rents, many of our veterans end up sleeping on the street and need our help.

There is no better tribute to the brave veterans that served at Fort Whipple than to use this land to provide a home, a community and a stable future for our veterans today.

In partnership with Gorman & Company, U.S.VETS — Prescott was selected to transform the VA Fort Whipple campus. This historic site was originally founded as home to the U.S. Army in 1863 and Arizona’s capital prior to the founding of Prescott. This project will honor the history of the land by building affordable supportive housing units for senior, homeless, and at-risk veterans in Northern Arizona. Six houses that served as officers’ quarters will be renovated for occupancy, and new housing developments will be built on 3 acres of land in the southwestern portion of the campus.
