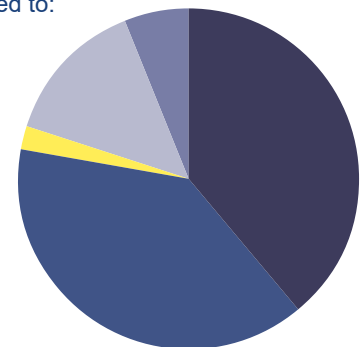

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

HOUSING

Transitional, emergency and permanent supportive, move-in and utility assistance, housing search, furniture and household goods

COUNSELING

Individual, family and group, mental health and substance abuse treatment, PTSD, CBT, anger management

CASE MANAGEMENT

Individualized case plans, goals, advocacy, benefits assistance, legal services, recreational activities

SUPPORTIVE SERVICES FOR VETERAN FAMILIES

Financial assistance, rent payments, eviction prevention services, general household items assistance, utility payments, car repairs, rapid re-housing

CAREER SERVICES

Career center, job interview skills, job search assistance, clothing, supportive employment needs

OUTREACH

Clothing, emergency shelter, food, and referrals to other services
