Harris County has the second largest veteran population in the United States. At any given time, there are approximately 4,000 homeless veterans sleeping on the streets in or around the Houston area. For as long as our brothers and sisters in arms struggle with food, shelter, mental health and jobs, U.S.VETS — Houston will continue to ensure no veteran is left behind.

For more than two decades, U.S.VETS — Houston has served homeless and at-risk veterans, providing housing, meals, counseling, career development, and case management to the men and women who have bravely served our country. In Houston, our programs serve more than 300 veterans daily. However, our current site no longer has the capacity to meet the housing and service needs of our clients.

OUR VISION is to provide a world-class veteran supportive housing campus for the men and women who have proudly served our country. U.S.VETS — Houston’s new campus will serve as a central hub for its residents and veterans in the community. It will provide both housing and essential clinical and programmatic services that our veterans have earned. The site will have an energy efficient design, and be conveniently located close to the VA Hospital, public transit, and neighboring centers of employment opportunities and education institutions.
