Financial assistance, rent payments, eviction prevention services, general household items assistance, utility payments, car repairs and rapid re-housing

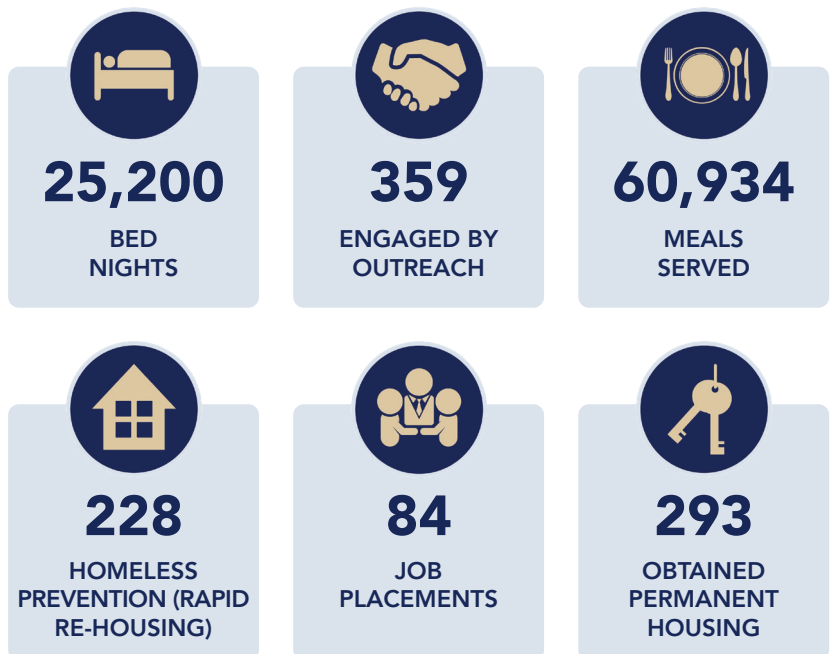
CAREER SERVICES

LIFE SKILLS GROUPS

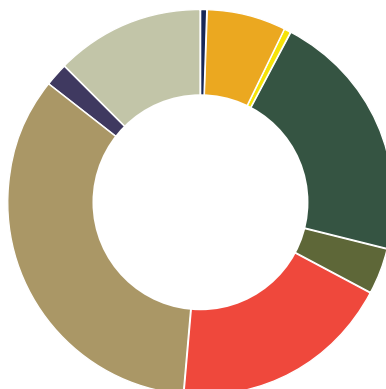
Culinary skills training, sobriety support, hiking, writing, motivation, meditation and art therapy

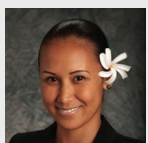


BUDGET
