HOUSING

Permanent supportive, transitional and emergency housing; assistance with housing search; furniture and household goods

COUNSELING

Individual, family and group counseling to treat mental health, substance use, post-traumatic stress disorder and anger

CASE MANAGEMENT

Individual housing and employment plans, goals, advocacy, benefits assistance, legal services and other community resources

OUTREACH

Food, clothing, emergency shelter and referrals

SUPPORTIVE SERVICES FOR VETERAN FAMILIES

Rapid re-housing and financial assistance including rent payments, security deposits, utilities, daily living, moving expenses and eviction prevention services

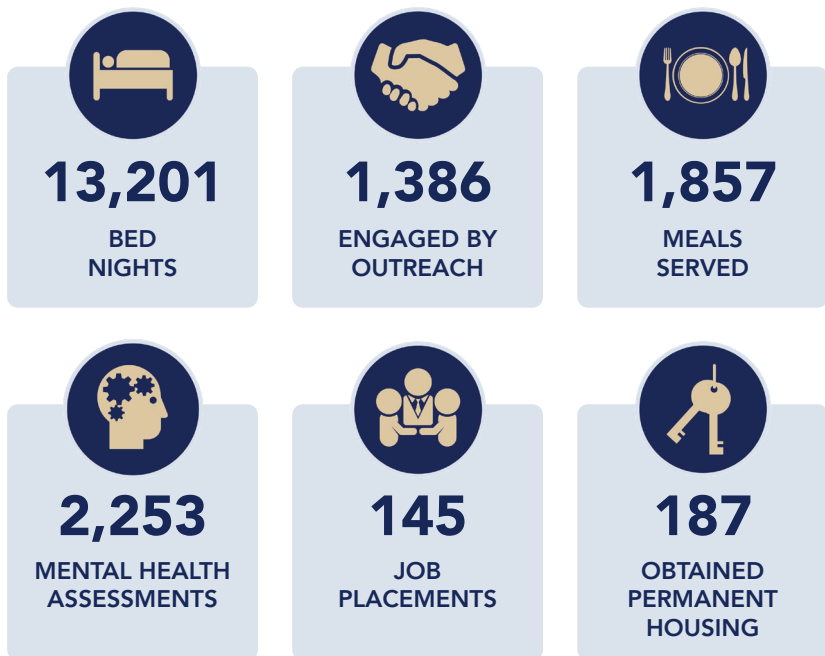
CAREER SERVICES

LIFE SKILLS GROUPS

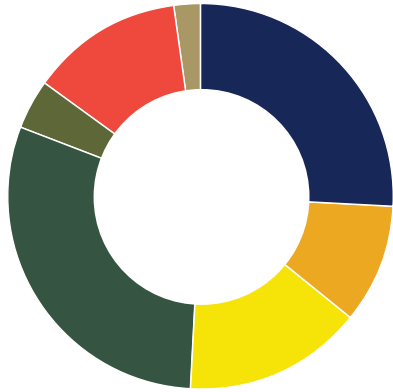
Financial literacy, culinary skills training, art therapy, computer literacy, outdoor activities and more
