Individualized case plans, goals, advocacy and benefits assistance

Clothing, emergency shelter and food

Financial assistance, rent payments, eviction prevention services, general household items assistance, utility payments, car repairs and rapid re-housing

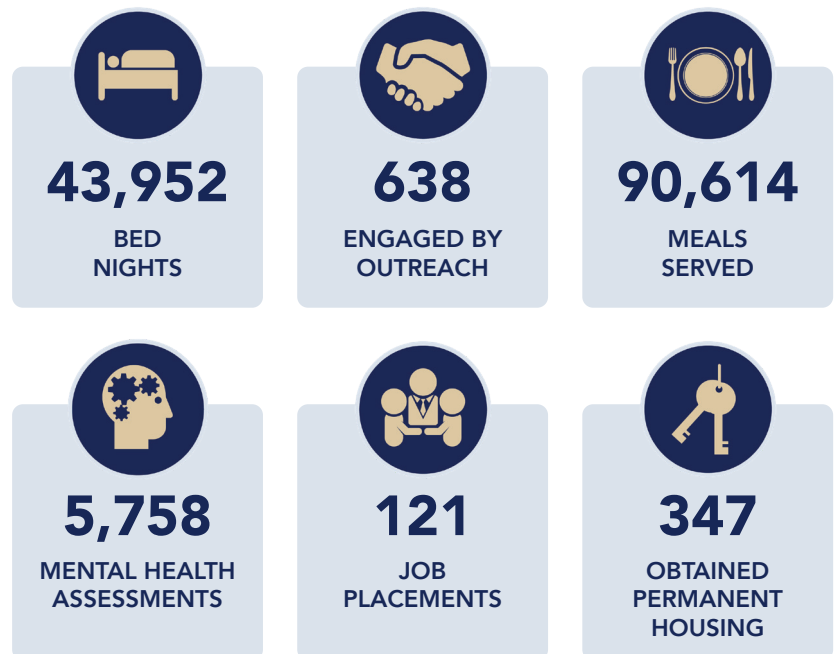
CAREER SERVICES

LIFE SKILLS GROUPS

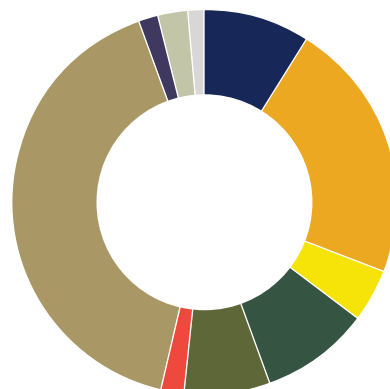
Culinary skills training, sobriety support, hiking, writing, motivation, meditation and art therapy
