Emergency, transitional and permanent housing; move-in assistance; utility assistance; housing search; furniture and household goods

COUNSELING

Individual and group mental health, post-traumatic stress disorder, substance abuse treatment and inner conflict

CASE MANAGEMENT

Individualized case plans, goals, advocacy and benefits assistance

OUTREACH

Clothing, emergency housing and food

SUPPORTIVE SERVICES FOR VETERAN FAMILIES

Financial assistance, rent payments, eviction prevention services, general household items assistance, utility payments, car repairs and rapid re-housing

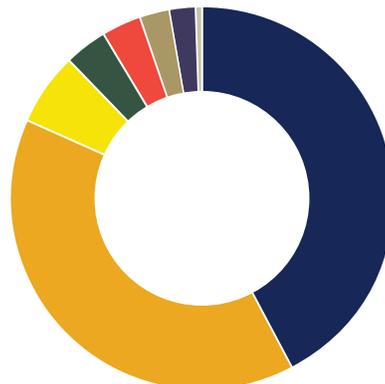
