### HOUSING

Transitional, emergency and permanent housing, move-in and utility assistance, housing search assistance, furniture and household goods assistance

### COUNSELING

Individual, family and group, mental health and substance abuse treatment, treatment for post-traumatic stress disorder, cognitive-based therapy and anger management

### CASE MANAGEMENT

Individualized case plans, goals, advocacy, benefits assistance, legal services and recreational activities

### SUPPORTIVE SERVICES FOR VETERAN FAMILIES

Financial assistance, rent payments, eviction prevention services, general household items assistance, utility payments, car repairs and rapid re-housing

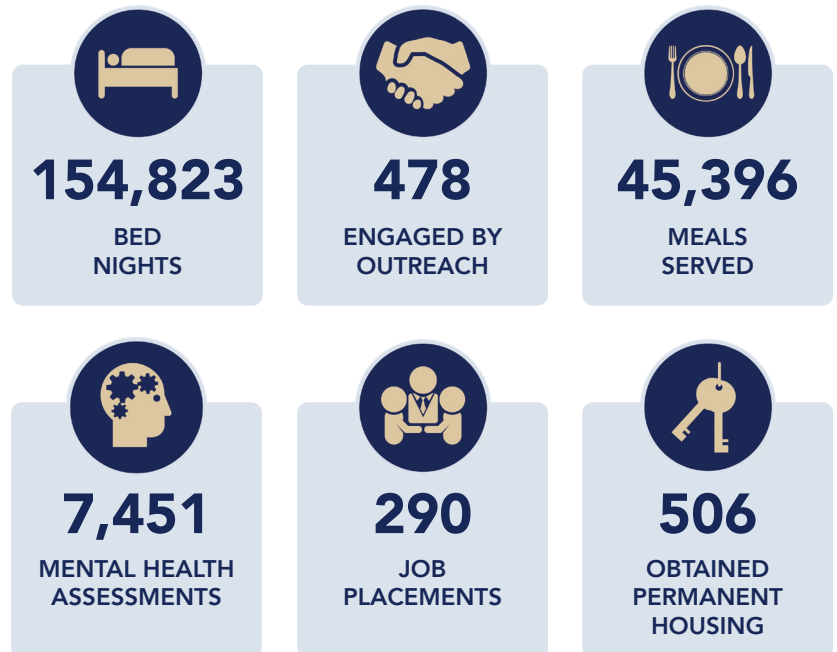
### CAREER SERVICES
